

General Pension Information

Teachers' Pension Plan

Employees who are qualified teachers' must contribute to the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan regardless of the position that they hold with the Board. This includes employees who may not currently be registered or working as a teacher presently.

Enrolment into the program is completed by the Pension Department at The Upper Canada District School Board and forwarded electronically to the Ontario Teachers' Pension Plan Board. The Pension Board contacts the new employee directly regarding membership into the plan.

OMERS Pension Plan

Any employee hired into a permanent position with the Upper Canada District School Board, **that is not a qualified teacher**, is enrolled in the OMERS pension plan.

Enrolment into the program is completed by the Pension Department at The Upper Canada District School Board. Once this is complete OMERS will send the employee a membership package.
